2 Getting Started

We recommend that you:

3 Your Video Distributor

The exceptionally high performance **VM-51** *1:5 Video Distributor* is a 1:5 distribution amplifier for video signals. In addition, the **VM-51**:

- Accepts one input² and distributes the signal to 5 identical outputs using BNC connectors
- Has an extra wide video bandwidth of 360MHz that allows for high-resolution data/video signals, SDI (serial digital) video and other specialized signals
 - Includes (Gain³) signal level and (EQ⁴.) equalization trimmer controls

⁴ For boosting the high frequencies to overcome cable losses

- Is DC coupled throughout for maximal signal fidelity, resulting in signal non-linearity lower than 0.1% and differential gain lower than 0.05%
- Is rugged, dependable and is housed in a miniature enclosure, smaller than "Kramer Tools"

Achieving the best performance means:

- Connecting only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoiding interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality and positioning your Kramer **VM-51** in a location free from moisture and away from excessive sunlight and dust




Figure 1: VM-51 1:5 Video Distributor

Table 1: Features and Functions of the VM-51 1:5 Video Distributor

#	Feature	Function
1	OUT BNC connectors	Connects to the video acceptors (up to 5)
2	12V DC	+12V DC connector for powering the unit
3	ON LED	Illuminates when receiving power
4	EQ. Trimmer	Adjusts ¹ the video EQ. (equalization) compensation
5	Gain Trimmer	Adjusts ¹ the video signal level
6	INPUT BNC connector	Connects to the video source

¹ Insert a screwdriver into the small hole and carefully rotate it, to trim the appropriate level

4 Connecting the Video Distributor




Figure 2: VM-51 1:5 Video Distributor Connections

To connect the VM-51, as the example in Figure 2 illustrates, do the following:

- 1. Connect a composite video source to the video *INPUT* BNC connector.
- 2. Connect up to 5 video output BNC connectors to the appropriate video acceptors.
- 3. Connect the power adapter to the power socket and connect the adapter to the mains electricity.
- 4. Adjust¹, if required, the output signal level (Gain) and/or the equalization level (EQ.).

¹ The unit is factory set for typical operating conditions. The controls may be tweaked if video amplification or high frequency enhancement is required (for example, when long cable runs are used)
