

### 3 Overview

The **PT-1DVI** is an ESD protector for DVI signals. The unit is used in Plug and Play applications to prevent damage to sensitive equipment as a result of ESD (electrostatic discharge), lightning or transient voltage surges.

More specifically, the PT-1DVI features:

- DVI-I input and output connectors
- Power-free operation

To achieve the best performance:

- Use only good quality connection cables<sup>1</sup> to avoid interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables).
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality and position your Kramer **PT-1DVI** away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust




Figure 1: PT-1DVI DVI ESD Protector

Figure 1 and Table 1 define the unit.

#	Feature	Function
1	INPUT DVI Connector	Connects to the DVI source
2	OUTPUT DVI Connector	Connects to the DVI acceptor

### 5 Connecting the PT-1DVI




Figure 2: Connecting the PT-1DVI DVI ESD Protector

To connect the **PT-1DVI**, as shown in Figure 2, do the following:

- 1. Connect the source (for example, a DVD player) to the INPUT DVI connector.
- 2. Connect the acceptor (for example, a display) to the OUTPUT DVI connector.

Labor and parts are warranted for three years from the date of the first customer purchase.

#### WHOIS PROTECTED?

Only the first purchase customer may enforce this warranty.

- Any product, on which the serial number has been defaced, modified or removed, or on which the WARRANTY VOID IF TAMPERED sticker has been torn, reattached, removed or otherwise interfered with.
- 3. Damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from:
  - i) Accident, misuse, abuse, neglect, fire, water, lightning or other acts of nature
  - ii) Product modification, or failure to follow instructions supplied with the product
  - iii) Repair or attempted repair by anyone not authorized by Kramer
  - iv) Any shipment of the product (claims must be presented to the carrier)
  - v) Removal or installation of the product
  - vi) Any other cause, which does not relate to a product defect
  - vii) Cartons, equipment enclosures, cables or accessories used in conjunction with the product
